

CALL FOR CHAPTERS 2024

OVERVIEW

Young scientists are invited to participate in the publication project "EUOPRENEURSHIP & SUSTAINABILITY", *free of charge*, which aims to gather opinions on entrepreneurship and sustainability in a European perspective in the current era of socio-economic turbulence. The project is in line with the EUOPRENEURSHIP theme and is the first of the publications to which young researchers are invited from among the representatives of scientific clubs and student organizations interested in the research on entrepreneurship and sustainable development in European countries.

The aim of the project is also to activate young researchers interested in the discussed topics, who will illustrate their reflections in the form of texts in English, submitted to the peer-reviewed monograph of international character.

#2 FULL TEXT

In a further stage, it will be necessary to send the full text of the chapter (8 to 15 A4 pages) by March 30, 2025 to the email address: obe@uek.krakow.pl according to the guidelines included in the attachment to this message.

Texts will then be reviewed and after appropriate corrections, the procedure of evaluation and indication of recommendations for publication will follow. The date of publication of the monograph is scheduled for October 2025.

TOPICS

Keeping in mind the most open formula of the conducted research and scientific considerations, detailed thematic blocks are NOT foreseen. The invitation applies to papers on the BROAD TOPIC OF ENTREPRENEURSHIP AND SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT AS WELL AS DIGITALIZATION, however, in the European context (EUOPRENEURSHIP).

DEADLINES

March 30, 2025 - deadline for submission of full texts

May 30, 2025 – feedback for Authors

June 30, 2025 – deadline for final submission

October 2025 - planned publication of texts
